Tournament rules

1 ELIGIBILITY OF STUDENTS

- * To be eligible participants must be Under 18 years of age (or under) and enrolled students at an Australian high school/college in the year of the event.
- * Any student participating in the tournament must have the permission of their school principal and be endorsed by their respective state associations.
- * All players participating in the tournament should be committed to the event and process of selection for the Australian Schoolboys.

2 TEAM SQUAD SIZE

- * A team list outlining 16 players, their playing number and school, must be submitted to the tournament hosts a week from commencement of the tournament.
- * Shadow (replacement) players may only be utilised, prior to the start of the tournament, to replace a player who, through injury or illness, is no longer able to participate in the tournament. The tournament hosts must be informed of any inclusion of Shadow players prior to the start of the tournament.
- * Any changes between NSW squads, or states with two participating teams must be made prior to the start of the tournament.

3 TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

All games are to be played according to FIFA International laws with the following amendments.

The following Interstate tournament rules apply:

The duration of matches will be-

35 minutes each way and with five minutes half time.

Time off for injuries and stoppages will be at the referee's discretion.

Points shall be awarded:-

WIN = 3 points

DRAW = 1 point

LOSS = 0 points

FORFEIT = 0 points

The competition will be conducted as a Round Robin: the team with the most competition points will be declared the winner, if points are equal, the winner will be determined by:

- i) Head-to-head result (if equal, then)
- ii) Goal difference (if equal, then)
- iii) Most goals scored, (if equal, then)
- iv) Penalty shootout

If a round is cancelled due to weather, the matches will be a draw.

Forfeit- if a team forfeits, the opposing team:

- i) receives winning competition points, plus the mean goal difference of other fixtures of that round if no other fixture, a goal difference of 3-0.
- ii) the forfeiting team must supply reasons for forfeit, in writing, to the tournament hosts before the next match.

Substitution-

- i) A team of 16 players may utilise up to 5 substitutes, including a goalkeeper, during any game.
- ii) Interchange is permissible (rolling substitution) throughout each fixture.

4 GENERAL

Referees-

The Referees are to be appointed by the State sporting organisation.

Footballs-

Match balls will be supplied by the organising committee.

Technical Area-

Players remaining in the technical area to wear a warmup bib. Only appointed state team management is permitted in the technical area.

Spectators- are to remain outside the fence if the field is enclosed, or well back from the sideline if the field is not enclosed.

Coaches- are to instruct all players: to play in a friendly spirit and the Football Australia and FIFA fair play policy. They should do all in their power to avoid unfair play and support the FIFA edict of fair play.

Presentation-

Medals will be provided by the host committee for the 1st & 2nd placegetters. The select Australian Schoolboys team will be announced at the presentation by the Australian Schools Football touring management.

Results-

Daily Results are to be published by the host committee.
